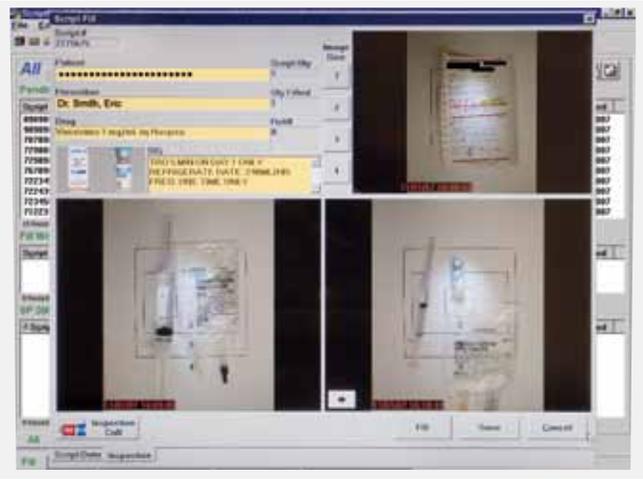


Cancer Clinic Pharmacy Employs Telepharmacy for Compounding Rooms

“The Avera Cancer Institute has three oncology clinics: gynecology, hematology, and medical. The pharmacy prepares medications for all three clinics. Chemotherapy is prepared in a negative pressure, hazardous drug compounding room. In the positive pressure, non-hazardous drug compounding room, we prepare antiemetics, premeds, etc. The pharmacy is staffed by two pharmacists and three technicians.

“We needed a system that would allow a pharmacist access to the sterile hazardous drug preparation room without having to leave the pharmacy to ‘gown and garb’ to enter the sterile room each time for verifying the chemotherapy solutions.

The technicians work inside the sterile rooms and the pharmacists are in the pharmacy.

“We know we’re saving money and time with SRMP because without it, the pharmacists would be gowning and garbing as many as 25 times per day. SRMP allows the pharmacists to utilize and manage their time better—they are able to evaluate patient orders and perform

medication management rather than taking time to gown and garb. It also prevents unnecessary exposure of hazardous drugs to staff.

“The reporting features greatly enhance our practice by helping us manage the scheduling of personnel, as well as our drug stock

inventory. We use the reports to track workflow and can adjust staffing based on our busy times. Another report sorts drugs by usage quantities so we know conclusively which drugs are being used and what we need to order.
